A Person's Soul is Precious

When King Saul was pursuing David, an occasion arose in which David could have killed Saul instead, but, as Saul later realized and admitted to David, "... my soul was precious in thine eyes this day," 1 Samuel 26:21. Saul had evidently not really considered the value of his own soul, but now, because of David's actions, he realized he had "played the fool."

Jesus' perspective on this subject is spelled out for us in Matthew 16:26: "What is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?"

Man's priorities are often poorly considered and greatly disordered. America is on a "health" binge, exercise becoming more and more

important, along with diet and nutrition. But our soul seems to be way down on that list. Sadly, though it is our only eternal possession and should be #1 on our list, it falls close to the bottom. Why not determine to place the proper value on your soul - it is your most precious possession!
