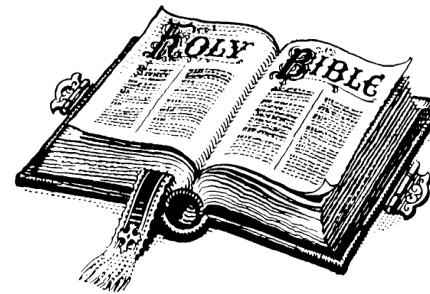
Wednesday Night:
