## Missions in American Samoa:

*Emotionally, we have had a hard week. On Saturday, we held a funeral for Henry Wilson. He was one of our most active members. He drove the van to pick people up for church, he worked with the youth and headed up most of the most on the new building. He leaves behind a wife and 3 small children. He was 46.*

*On Thursday night, one of the children at church died at the hospital. She had an enlarged heart and a serious heart murmur. She had fallen while playing at her house. Although, the cuts and scrapes were healing fine, her heart began to give her problems. After almost a week in the hospital, it looked like she was getting ready to go home, when she had heart failure and died. Her name is Frances Siaulaiga and she was 12 years old. Her father was off-island, so final funeral plans will not be made until he returns on Thursday (the first flight he was able to get on to return home).*
