One dark and stormy night in a fishing town on the coast of Maine, a little boy wandered away from his house. He climbed to the top of a steep cliff overhanging a pounding surf. At the cliff's edge, he slipped and fell to a tiny ledge fifteen feet down the rocks. Some men and boys, searching for the lost child, saw his unconscious form on the ledge. "We need someone who is strong but lightweight," one of the men said. "We can lower him by rope until he reaches the child."

All of the boys in the group looked over the edge of the cliff. They saw the raging ocean a hundred feet below. They felt the fury of the northeastern wind tear at their clothes. Finally, one boy stepped forward. "I will try," he said, "if you let my Dad hold the rope."
